



## DRESS CODE 2009-2010

A higher standard of dress encourages greater respect for individual students and results in a higher standard of behavior. Our dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school dress for normal school days. The school administration reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/or make changes during the school year. Students are expected to follow these guidelines. The school uniform shall be worn by every student while in school and on the school bus. Personal coats/jackets and hats may be worn to/from school but must be left in student locker during the day. Book bags and purses must be in lockers during the school day.

**Hair:** Hair must be neat and clean with no distracting colors or cuts, i.e. florescent, Mohawks, spiked looks, or designs in scalps. No hats, bandanas, doo rags, or headbands may be worn.

**Misc:** Students may not wear sunglasses. Students may not wear body piercing other than hoop earrings or studs in their ear lobes. No nose, tongue, eyebrow or lip piercing are allowed. No Gothic looks, dog collars, spiked jewelry etc. or any other accessories deemed inappropriate by the faculty or administration. At no time are students allowed to wear anything offensive, immodest, or deemed inappropriate by the faculty or administration.

**Shoes:** Students must wear closed heel and closed toe shoes at all times. No sandals, flip-flops, Croc style shoes, bedroom slippers, boots, or shoes with metal tips may be worn.

**Uniforms:** All clothing worn during the school day must have the GCHS logo and will be available **only** through the school store. Uniforms are to be worn alone without other clothing showing under or over the uniform and polo's are to be tucked in at all times. Belts are required and must be solid and plain in blue, black, and corium. Bottoms must be worn at the waist.

Boys may wear GCHS logo uniform shorts or pants in navy or khaki only. Girls may wear GCHS logo uniform shorts, capris, or pants in navy and khaki only. **NO OTHER COLORS** are allowed. The length of the shorts may not be shortened for any reason.

Both boys and girls may only wear GCHS logo polo shirts in navy or grey. These polo shirts may be short or long-sleeved. No oxford shirts are allowed. The only outer wear allowed during the school day is GCHS logo zip fleeces or sweatshirts.

Students out of uniform will be assigned a consequence for dress code violation. Repeated dress code violators will be allowed to return to school only with a parent/guardian for a prearranged meeting. Uniform compliance is necessary in order for students to be invited for continuing attendance.

**Gym** Mesh shorts and the screen-printed Griffin tee shirt must be purchased

**Uniform:** through the Physical Education teacher and are to be worn only in gym class.
