Topics Discussed, Tasks Assigned and Decisions Made:

All members signed in and the meeting agenda was distributed.

**Agenda Items:**

- The minutes from the last SAC meeting dated April 9, 2013 for GCIS and GCHS were reviewed by the members of the committee and approved.

\* **Mrs. Abraham** discussed the FCAT scores which have not come in as of yet. The retakes for the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders came in on the May 16, 2013. There was a great improvement for the school and there was a 41% increase in the number of students who passed the FCAT.

\*Mrs. Abraham mentioned the results of our A+ money proposal.

There was a mixed opinions review about the way the distribution was decided for the middle and high school ballots and results. A mutual decision was decided amongst the committee that a few options be amended. The ballot for proposed question #2 stated should instructional and non instructional staff who left the employment of GCHS during this school year receive a share of the A+ money? It was decided that a revision be made which states that instructional and non instructional staff must be employed the entire school year 2012-2013 school year by CSUSA. They must also remain employed until the distribution of the A+ money in the 2013-2014 school year. By including this statement it would help to alleviate any confusion on who exactly will receive the money.

All other questions of the proposed ballot were reviewed and approved.

\***Mrs. Burns** discussed the results of the ballots for the A+ money for the middle school faculty and staff. There was a mixed opinions review about the way the distribution was decided for the middle school ballots and results. A mutual decision was decided amongst the committee that a few options be amended.

The ballot for proposed question #1 stated how should the A+ money be distributed among the GICS faculty and staff?

It was decided that a revision be made which states that instructional and non instructional staff should choose from 2 options 50/50 or 60/40. By including this statement it would help to alleviate any confusion on who exactly will receive the money.

The proposed ballot with question #8 should include dates, percentages of dollar amounts, relocating to another CSUSA school.

All other questions of the proposed ballot were reviewed and approved.

\*Mrs. Brady discussed the rosters of employees be saved for the distribution of A+ money. This would help to make sure the money is distributed to all employees who worked for the 2012-2013 school year.
