## Agenda Items:

- The minutes from the last SAC meeting dated September 11, 2013 were reviewed by the members of the committee and approved.
- \*Mrs. Eastwood gave a brief update for the School Improvement Plan for the High School as well as the Middle School. She explained changes that were made to the forms which now have more specific demands. The document targets more of the needs of students, such as the lowest 25%, the four core subjects, benchmark data, and FCAT retakes from October. The documents also target the ESOL and ESE students and the PERK testing which determines the readiness of our juniors and seniors for college. The document had a deadline for state which was November 1. It was approved by the state and continues to change as results change.
- \* Mrs. Abraham mentioned the Title II funds. Title II funds are determined based on the number of students eating free or reduced lunch. She mentioned how it would be disbursed among our three schools. The funds will be used to assist teachers in continuous professional development. We hope to get books for teachers tailored toward leadership, send teachers to conferences for enrichment, and guest speakers to come in for motivation and creativity. The proposal was approved by the committee. It was mentioned that last school year Mrs. Vargas and Mrs. Eastwood benefited from professional development conferences, which help them to gain a better insight for helping our students.
- \* In guidance News, Ms. Higginbotham spoke about the parent night that took place on October 17, 2013. The parent night entailed graduation requirements, volunteer hours, and college visits taking place for the students during their lunch. Many colleges have already visited our students such as FIU, FAU, FGCU, and others just to name a few. The students are very excited and look forward to acceptance letters from colleges in December.
