Topics Discussed, Tasks Assigned and Decisions Made:

Meeting opened at 3:30 p.m. Members were introduced and where they represent. All members signed in and the prior meeting agenda were distributed.

Agenda Items:

The minutes from the last SAC meeting dated January 15, 2014 were reviewed by the members of the committee and approved.

2. Benchmark 3 data was reviewed by Mrs. Jensen. The proficiency percentages were discussed and gains/weaknesses were covered.

3. Mr. Yearsley discussed the golf tournament that GCHS athletic department will host on May 31, Saturday. Last year, \$12,000 was raised and the goal for this year is \$20,000. There is a 3 year plan to replace the gym floor with hard-wood.

4. Mr. Yearsley covered the spring sports records so far. Softball is 3-5, baseball (7-2), girls tennis (2-7), boys tennis (7-2). Districts are coming up for these sports. Sixteen students qualified for the Disney meet in Orlando for track and field.

5. Mr. Yearsley discussed middle school sports. The boys soccer completed their season and the girls went 3 rounds in the district tournament. Middle school track, tennis, and golf will begin in the upcoming weeks.

6. A plus money allocations will need to be voted on at the next meeting in May.

7. **In guidance** News, Ms. Higginbotham spoke regarding course requests beginning in the high school. She discussed that there were a few students awarded \$12-14000 in scholarship from Stetson University.

8. Testing dates are approaching, FCAT retakes will begin 4/7 and FCAT will begin 4/14. EOC's will begin 4/21.

9. NHS participated in a number of walk, car washes, raising pennies for leukemia, donated ice cream to the middle and high.

10. The teachers present each spoke about how they are supporting the upcoming testing and the instructional strategies that are showing gains with the students.
